Clare county council is putting in a pedestrian crossing and they have started already. They have cut the wall at the car park and the school and they have started putting in curbs. Aidan

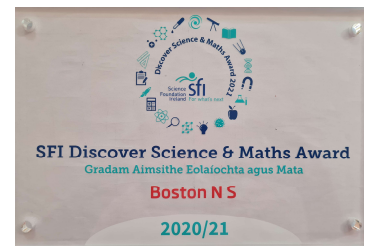


Building Update

Christmas Cards

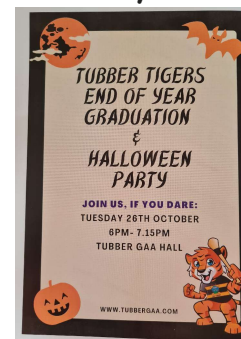
We have made Christmas cards again this year. They are €10 for a 10 pack. We made some for people who don't have kids in the school. We had lots of fun making them.
